Whereas, Our camp will be forced to raise our annual dues to cover these exorbitant increases by the National SUVCW, our Brothers will question whether to belong to the SUVCW and Camp 64 under this onerous burden.

Whereas, The Camp as the whole considers the dues increase irresponsible by unanimous vote.

Be it Resolved, that the Army of the Tennessee, Camp 64, Department of Tennessee, SUVCW **strongly disapproves** of the National Headquarters raising the annual dues per Brother by almost seventy percent.

This will be an unwelcome burden, financially on our membership and we will likely lose members.

Be it further Resolved, that this resolution was presented to the Brothers of the Army of the Tennessee and discussed and voted on to present this resolution to the National SUVCW Headquarters.
